

TRADE SITE RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING CLAUSES RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF SITE OR EVICTION FROM GROUNDS

1. **OUTDOOR SITES ONLY.**
2. **CHECK IN:** Stallholders are to check in at the Secretary's office on arrival. You will then be directed to your site by the Secretary or Industrial Space Steward.
3. **SETTING UP:** Stalls to be set up by 9am on Show Day – gates open from 6am for livestock exhibitors, so you have plenty of time to get in and set up. Vehicle movement will not be permitted after that time. Sites can be set up on Saturday. Please get in touch with the Secretary if you need to come earlier.
4. **PACKING UP:** Stalls can begin packing up after 3:30pm – the show begins to wind down from 4pm with the collection of exhibits.
5. **PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE:** The Finley Show Society will not, under any circumstances, be held responsible for any loss or damage to the stock in trade, etc., or any part thereof, of any space holder and/or exhibitor from any cause whatsoever. INSURANCE IS THE STALLHOLDERS RESPONSIBILITY. A PUBLIC LIABILITY POLICY FOR \$20 MILLION MUST BE SITED OR A POLICY FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW IS AVAILABLE AT A COST OF \$20. Your certificate of currency must be provided when lodging this application.
6. **EQUIPMENT:** A limited number of marquees and trestle tables are available to hire for the duration of the Show. Otherwise, stall holders are required to provide their own equipment.
7. **BANNED ITEMS:** The following items are NOT permitted to be sold or on the grounds:
 - Bouncing beans; Drug related goods (including Cocaine Kits, Bongs, etc); Electric hands; Explicit & hardcore t-shirts; Explicit DVDs & videos; Fake cigarettes; Fireworks – crackers; Fuel type fire lighters (Zippo); Horns & trumpets; Iridescent hair spray; Knives (including pen knives) – excluding appropriately packaged kitchenware sets; Laser pen lights/pointers; Metal & wooden martial art nunchakas; Playing cards (nude or lurid); Pressure pack fart gas; Pressure pack silly string; Pressure pack snow; Silly string; Stink bombs; Water bombs
 - Toy guns are acceptable, however, the following are NOT - Ball bearing guns; Eight shot caps; Guns that are designed to project any form of object or projectile; Pellet guns; Pop downs (throw downs); Replica guns (bullet type); Roll caps (caps only banned); Strip caps (caps only banned); Water pistols over 150mm (6")
8. The allotted area is to be used only for the purpose specified in this application. Selling, hawking or distribution of printed or other matter is not permitted outside the area allotted.
9. The running of raffles by stall holders is prohibited.
10. NO Trader, under any circumstances, will be allotted a site in the Guild area.
11. All electrical appliances, cables and gas bottles must be tagged, stamped and in date.
12. Stall holders are responsible to meet all OH&S standards.
13. Public address systems, projectors or sound units must not operate at a noise level which inconveniences the showground's public address system, the public or other stall holders.
